INTRODUCTION

Your legal expenses cover applies to your business as described in your commercial insurance policy schedule, and directors, officers and employees of that business where they are acting in that capacity.

	There is an excess of £250 in respect of all claims under the debt recovery section of cover and an excess of £200 in respect of all claims under the Tax Disputes (aspect enquiries only) section of cover.

Legal costs to: Pursue or defend a dispute with a customer or supplier over a contract to supply goods or services.	Claims will only be covered where the amount in dispute is at least £250 but no more than £5,000.	Contract
